Youth Worker (Part-Time) - 2026 School Year

New Life Church Fremantle (NLC), a vibrant and growing community, is hiring a part-time Youth Worker for the 2025 school year. This is a missional role designed to establish relationships with Fremantle Christian College (FCC) secondary students in order to lead them to Christ and connect them with New Life Church.

WHO WE ARE LOOKING FOR

We seek someone with wholehearted devotion to Jesus, a passion for discipleship, and a desire to reach youth and families with the Gospel.

Do I need to attend New Life Church?

You are not required to change churches for this role, but you must regularly attend a Christian church and be willing to support the beliefs, vision, and values of NLC.

NEW LIFE YOUTH VISION

Our vision is to see high school students become disciples of Jesus who know, love and obey him.

- Active and growing personal relationship with Jesus Christ, evidenced by action, attitude and behaviour.
- Passionate about discipling youth and families
- Energetic, loyal, teachable, and a team player
- Committed to excellence in ministry and work
- Compassionate and service-oriented, following Jesus' heart for the good of others
- Practices daily habits of prayer, worship, Bible study, and obedience to God
- Currently holds or is able to obtain a Working With Children Check (WWCC)
- Previous experience in youth work is preferred but not essential

RESPONSIBILITIES

1. Relationships, Relationships

Ministry is about building and nurturing relationships that honour God and make disciples.

2. Maintain Emotionally Healthy Relationships

You are responsible for maintaining emotionally healthy relationships with God, the Youth Pastor, the Youth team, youth, parents, and Fremantle Christian College (FCC) staff.

3. In the context of those relationships, you will:

- a) Serve under the leadership of the Youth Pastor
- b) Communicate appropriately with the Youth Pastor, ministry team, youth, parents, and FCC staff
- c) Participate in the weekly Youth Worker meeting
- d) Help facilitate Friday night youth programs each week
- e) Connect with FCC high school students weekly by:
 - i) Attending one lunchtime per week
 - ii) Organising activities to engage students during lunchtimes (e.g., dodgeball, soccer games)
 - iii) Discipling students through a weekly Bible study
 - iv) Participating in one high school class per week (usually an elective subject like woodwork, food studies, or physical education)
 - v) Inviting students to Friday night youth events
 - vi) Serving at the FCC Year 7 camp at the start of the year (subject to availability, with an additional payment for attending the camp)

4. Receive Coaching

Ongoing coaching and support will be provided by the Youth Pastor to help you grow in your role.

Pay and Conditions

The role is equivalent to 0.2 FTE (7.5hrs/week).

Hourly rate based Australian National Minimum Wage with adjustments for experience and qualifications.
